As we have been praying about our compliance issues, I shared the song by **Tasha Layton**, "Worship **Through It**", <u>https://youtu.be/pBeivKtQ0RM?si=kNNMytMLY121YjtK</u>. I have continued "worshiping **through"** with this song as I continue to pray about what is needed for compliance. What we have to raise is BIG. But **OUR GOD IS BIGGER!** "This looks impossible, but You're the God of impossible." "I know my God can do it. So, I'm gonna worship through it."

Of the total \$23,794 that we needed, we have raised \$15,775! That leaves just the Poultry Project and the Hospital Project!

**POULTRY PROJECT:** The poultry project is required as a self-sustainability project to help with our monthly budget needs. It also will help equip our students that help with skills and develop an income generating mindset. When the chickens start laying eggs, the money we receive from selling

eggs can offset an item or two from the monthly budget. Total needed: \$5,342

**HOSPITAL PROJECT:** This is a required **COMMUNITY SUPPORT PROJECT.** All homes need to find ways to have more of a direct impact on the community. Our proposed Hospital Project will affirm our impact in our community. **Total Needed: \$2,677** 

**MONTHLY BUDGET:** Please pray for our monthly regular budget. **Because of all the major compliance needs, our monthly budget has been running low.** The budget needs in Uganda average close to **\$2,400 a month.** The last two months we have not been able to cover it all. Godfrey ends up have to make cuts, mainly in the area of food. Pray as part of our 15th Anniversary Celebration we can raise funds to get back on track with sending Godfrey the full amount at the beginning of the month.

**CAR REPAIR:** We are thankful to have the van fully paid off! Godfrey's car has been repaired because we needed to have two vehicles working for compliance. Continue praying for the **\$958** needed to cover the cost of a new transmission.
