RAINING HOPE would like to bless at least 12 families with food this Christmas!


This will be for the families of our children. Many families have continued to struggle with the rising cost of food and supplies. We would provide **food baskets** of rice, beef, cooking oil, sugar, bread, butter, soap, salt & fuel. We also want to provide enough to carry them through the New Year. This includes the families of our

students who have graduated as they are still an active part of our ministry.

The cost: \$420 or \$35 per family. Because we are still catching up on budget needs, we will first raise enough to take care of our student's families. If additional funds come in we will bless more of the needy families in the community.

If you would like to sponsor a family or give a designated amount, please contact Carol John or Mama Eydie. We would like to send the funds this week so Godfrey has time to purchase the food.







- 1. PRAISE REPORT: We have received the official operating permit!!! It is good for one year. We will have to renew it annually. This is a huge answer to prayer!
- 2. **PRAISE REPORT!** We received a generous donation to fund the rest of the poultry project!
- 3. Budget We still need your prayers as our monthly budget is still running low. The budget needs in Uganda average close to \$2,400 a month. The last five months we have not been able to cover it all. Compliance issues, higher school fees, an increase in the monthly radio costs and a decrease in monthly sponsorships has contributed to the budget challenges. Godfrey has bought some things on credit and waited to pay other

bills. We are praying as part of our 15th Anniversary Celebration we can raise funds to get back on track with sending Godfrey the full amount at the beginning of the month. We need \$708 to complete the budget for December.

- 4. Insurance Comprehensive The yearly bill of \$342 is currently due.
- 5. Car Repair: Continue praying for Godfrey's car that needed a new transmission. The repair cost was \$958.

IN-DEPTH PRAISE & PRAYER FESTIVAL

Raining Hope organized an **In-Depth Praise service on December 8, 2024.** This was our third annual event! It was a huge success! During this time, they invited choirs and guest singers to come as well as other churches for the praise of our God. It was a time of celebrating God for who He is. We experienced some people being filled with the Spirit of God and others praying like never before. There was joy on everyone's faces. One testimony came from a young man who attended the In-Depth Praise service and was delivered from oppression. We thank God for our young adults at the home because they are well spoken of for their skill in singing and playing musical instruments. It was a great time of outreach for the community as well.
